

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/26/024 – LISAVAIRD CO-OP/MORGANS FINE FISH

Section 21 of the Competition Act 2002

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby Lisavaird Co-operative Creamery Limited would acquire sole control of Seafood Processors Limited (which trades as Morgans Fine Fish).

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby Lisavaird Co-operative Creamery Limited, through Lisavaird Food Group Limited, would acquire the entire issued share capital, and thus sole control, of Seafood Processors Limited (Morgans Fine Fish). The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 2 April 2026.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

Lisavaird Co-operative Creamery Limited is an agricultural co-operative society that carries on a variety of businesses in the agricultural, retail, food production, renewable energy and property rental sectors.

Lisavaird Food Group Limited is a wholly owned subsidiary of Lisavaird Co-Operative Creamery Limited, and, through certain subsidiaries, is active in the State in the processing and supply of seafood.

Seafood Processors Limited trades as Morgans Fine Fish and processes and supplies fresh, frozen and smoked seafood produce to customers in the State. Its facility is located in Omeath, Co. Louth.
