

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/26/046 – MHL DUBLIN AIRPORT/BOHRMOUNT

Section 21 of the Competition Act 2002

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby MHL Dublin Airport Hotel Limited, ultimately controlled by Irish Holdings II LLC, would acquire sole of Bohrmount Limited.

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby MHL Dublin Airport Hotel Limited, ultimately controlled by Irish Holdings II LLC, would acquire sole control of Bohrmount Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 17 July 2026.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

MHL Dublin Airport Hotel Limited is immediately controlled by the Dublin Airport Hotel Partnership (DAHP). The DAHP is ultimately wholly controlled by Irish Holdings II LLC. Irish Holdings II LLC owns and operates a number of hotels in the State, trading as MHL Hotel Collection.

Through its subsidiary Bohrmount Limited II, Bohrmount Limited owns and operates two hotel properties located at Dublin Airport, namely the Crowne Plaza Dublin Northwood and the Holiday Inn Express Dublin Airport.
