

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/26/056 – ORIX AVIATION/ AERFIN

Section 21 of the Competition Act 2002

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby ORIX Aviation Systems Limited would acquire sole control of AerFin Limited.

16 September 2026

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has cleared the proposed transaction whereby ORIX Aviation Systems Limited, would acquire sole control of Atlantic Holdco Limited, the ultimate parent company of AerFin Limited together with its direct and indirect subsidiaries and branches. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 25 August 2026.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

ORIX Aviation Systems Limited (“ORIX Aviation”) is an aircraft operating lessor and asset manager, owning and managing commercial aircraft to airline customers in over 40 countries. ORIX Aviation is a wholly owned subsidiary of ORIX Corporation, which is headquartered in Japan.

AerFin Limited (“Aerfin”) is an aviation aftermarket specialist which buys, sells, leases and repairs aircraft engines and parts for airlines, maintenance repair and overhaul providers, aviation brokers and aviation leasing companies globally. AerFin is headquartered in Newport, Wales.
