



# PRODUCT RECALLS

## Renault recalls Clio and Wind models

 SEPTEMBER 14, 2011

Renault Ireland is carrying out a voluntary recall of Clio and Wind models sold in the Republic of Ireland. The recall affects all vehicles fitted with any of the following engines:

1.2 16V petrol engine and TCe 100 petrol engine, manufactured between **17 September 2010** and **30 November 2010**

16V Flex Fuel engine and 1.2 16V petrol engine, manufactured between **6 November 2010** and **22 November 2010**

Renault Ireland has taken the decision to recall these models due to a valve issue that could cause damage to the engine.

This recall affects 388 vehicles in Ireland.

### What to do:

Letters will be sent by Renault Ireland to the owners of affected vehicles informing them of the recall and asking them to contact their [🔗 nearest Renault dealer](#) to arrange for the necessary work to be carried out as soon as possible.

Any work carried out as part of this recall will be completed free of charge.
